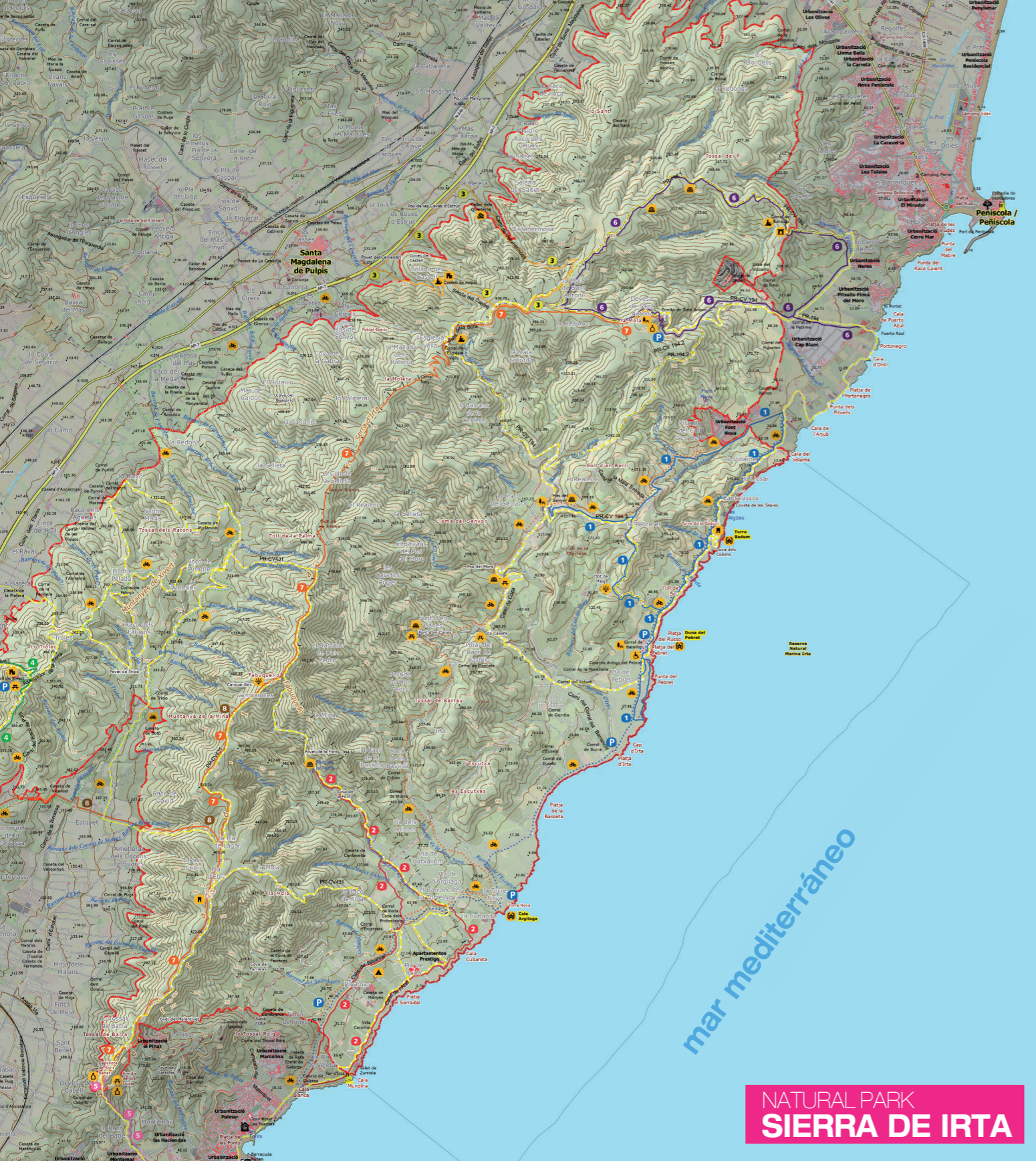

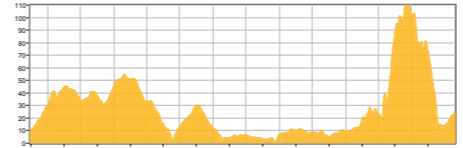

Bicycle itinerary: Cranc Route

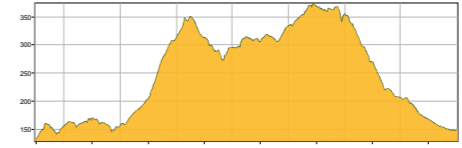
Departure: Playa de Las Fuentes
Arrival: Cala Volante



Description of the route: Before arriving at the lighthouse of Alcossebre in the Urbanization Las Fuentes, you access the Ribamar track, at the beginning of which we find the signage of the itinerary by bike. This track runs parallel to the coast and leads us to Cala Volante (geographical boundary of the PN. de la serra d'Irta) and then by road to the municipality of Peñíscola. The route presents as its only difficulty the climb to Torre Badum, a steep slope stretch, which is located past the Pla de Pebret.

Bike itinerary: Xariguer Route

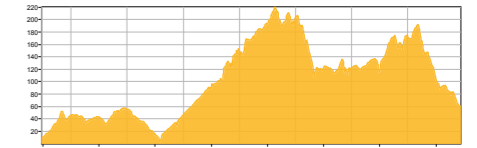
Departure: St. Magdalene of Pulpis
Arrival: Alcalé de Xivert



Route description: From the Alcossebre coast, along the Ribamar track, you can access the interior of the Naciontal Park. of the Serra d'Irta. Following this track parallel to the coast, a very steep curve brings us closer to Cala Argilaga, and then we find a detour to the left indicated by Font dén Canes. Then there is another fork on the right, where the recreation area of the Caseta is located. We leave this detour behind and continue the path along the Pou del Moro, Mas del Senyor and arrive at the Font Nova urbanization.

Bike itinerary : Fardaxo Route

Departure: Playa de las Fuentes
Arrival: Font Nova Urbanization



Route description: The route begins in the town of Santa Magdalena de Pulpis, concretely on the service track that is parallel to the highway. You continue along this road, in a south direction for 2 kilometers, until you reach a point where you can access the N-340 road or deviate to the left. We continue on the left and a few meters there is a detour to the right, but it must continue straight. It is passed near the Ametler's watch point and a water tank for forest fires. Then there is a fork, take the path on the right, which passes through the Widow's corral and arrives at Xivert Castle. Leaving behind the castle goes down the track to the road of l'Estopet, already asphalted, and passes through the hermitage of Calvari before reaching the town of Alcalá de Xivert.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR VISITING THE PARK

- Take the trash and put it in the container as you leave the park
- Respect the road and attend to the signs
- Don't light fires
- Respect the flora
- Respect wildlife
- Take care of sources, don't contaminate them
- It is not allowed to travel with quad bikes, etc. (Decree 8/2008, of January 25 th, of the Ministry)
- Ride a bike or horseback only along the forest tracks
- Speed limited to 30 km/hr
- Camping is not allowed
- Prohibited any type of overnight stay
- Take animals tied up to avoid discomfort
- Respect the Cultural Historical Heritage
- In case of emergency call 112

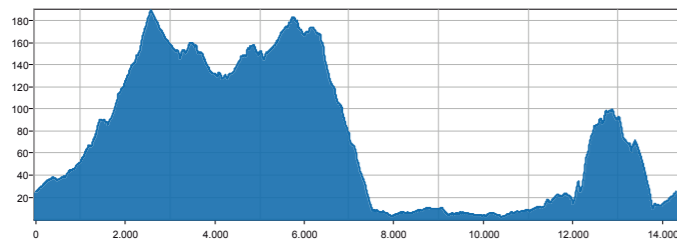
NATURE RESERVE USES NOT ALLOWED

- Anchoring boats outside the places established for this purpose
- Sea surface recreation fishing from boat
- Underwater recreational fishing
- Recreational recreational fishing on foot from the coast along the entire coastline of the Marine Reserve, ranging from Cala Volante to Cala Mundina, both included
- The seafood of bivalve molluscs, on foot or from boat
- Water sports using motor boats



1 Circular itinerary through mas del Senyor, Clot de Maig, Dunas del Pebret and Torre Badum

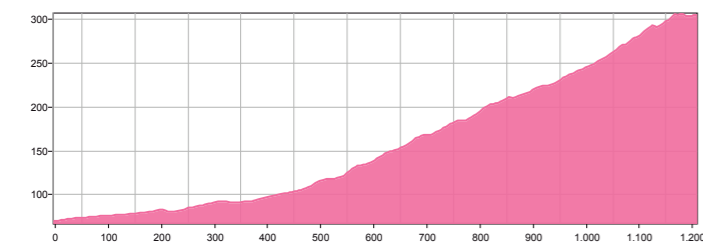
Departure: Font Nova
Arrival Urbanization: Font Nova Urbanization



Description of the route: In the town of Peñíscola, following the indicates of the natural park, before reaching the Font Nova urbanization, we will find a panel of the Natural Park indicating the entrance to the Protected Natural Area. It is advisable to leave the vehicle at this point and start the river itinera in the direction of Font Nova. The first of the stops is the Lord's Mas. After a break in this bleak olmeda, we return on our steps, until we find the junction that indicates the direction to Badum tower, from here, the route runs along an old path that leads to the area called Clot de Maig. We continue the descent until we reach the front line. Once there, we take the track on the right to visit the dunes of Pebret Beach, which are only 500 m away, then we back off until we reach the emblematic Badum tower. Continuing along the track we return to the beginning of the tour.

5 Itinerary to the Hermitage of Santa Llucia i Sant Benet

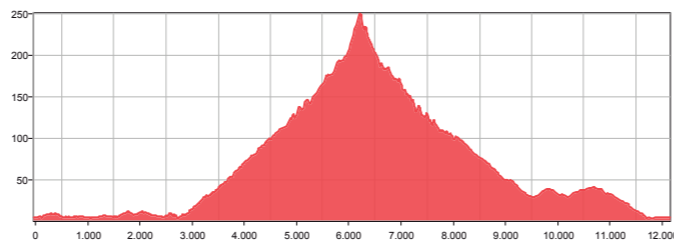
Departure: Montemar Urbanization – Oliveres Street
Arrival: Montemar Urbanization



Description of the route: Entering Alcossebre from the N-340 road we find a roundabout and we deviate direction urbanization Las Fuentes. After 1.5 km we find on the left a wooden sign, which coincides with Oliveres street (Urbanization Montemar). At the end of this street, when the asphalt ends, we find the path that will take us to the hermitage of Santa Llúcia and Sant Benet. This route allows us to enjoy beautiful views. The coastline is drawn from Oropesa to the lighthouse d'Irta in Alcossebre.

2 Circular itinerary Faro d'Irta, Cala Cubanita, Font de la Parra

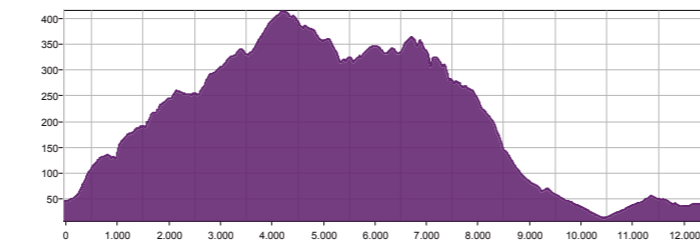
Departure: Cala Blanca
Arrival: Cala Blanca



Description of the route: We arrive by the N340 road to the detour that Alcossebre tells us, from there we head direction urbanization Las Fuentes and following the signs of the natural parc we arrive in Cala Blanca in the vicinity of the lighthouse d'Irta. From the lighthouse begins the itinerary, we cross the malentivet ravine that flows into the well-known Mundina cove (geographical boundary of the Natural Park de la Serra d'Irta). The path runs parallel to the sea at all times. One of the most representative enclaves is the Serradal beach, spectacular for its high mound of boulders eroded by the sea and for the contributions of sand and shells that accumulate between the rocks. This part of the tour is very smooth and suitable to perform with the little ones. Once past the Prestige apartments, the path takes place on the rock, getting closer to the sea until you reach Cubanita cove. We will leave Cubanita cove to find the forest track where the sign indicates that Font de la Parra tells us that passes following the channel of the ravine. This climb gives us a clear representation of the Mediterranean riverside vegetation, with some peculiarity such as the black sabina specimens.

6 Circular itinerary Alto de Vistahermosa - Hermitage Saint Antoni

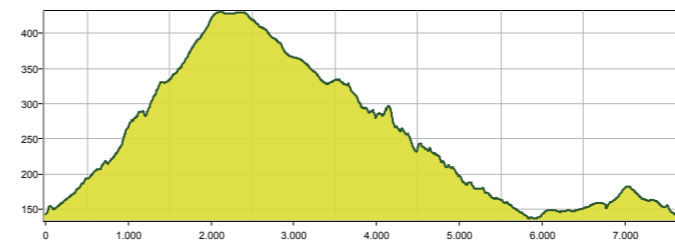
Departure: Urbanization Nerea
Arrival Urbanization Nerea



Description of the route: From the municipality of Peñíscola we head along the coast road towards the Natural Park. We take the detour to enter the Nerea urbanization. After leaving the vehicle at the end of the urbanization, leave the path to the right towards the corral de Baltasar. We continue on ascent passing through the "bassa groga", until we reach the crossing of Santahermosa. At this point we begin the descent towards the hermitage of Sant Antoni. We will leave the hermitage and on the main track we descend to return to the starting point.

3 Circular itinerary Polpis Castle - Boixar Canyon

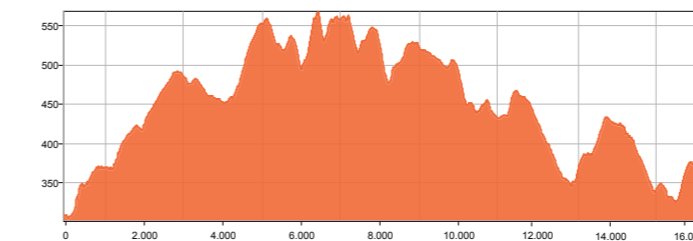
Departure: Cemetery
Arrival: Cemetery



Description of the tour: From the town of Santa Magdalena de Pulpis, we head towards the cemetery. We cross the highway through the underpass and find the indication of the start of the path. We walk among dry crops, until the path narrows and enters the ravine. During the tour we find remains of ancient lime kilns, today transformed into stone shelters. The ascent of this bleakness is very pleasant until reaching the last stretch, before reaching the castle, where the slope becomes more steep. From the castle we will pass between the walls of old corrals in the direction of the Bco. Boixar. We continue along the stretch of track towards Sant Antoni until the junction with Vistahermosa. Continuing along this path, we find the detour towards the Boixar ravine (left). The descent down this ravine is very smooth and ends on the AP-7 highway service track. We return by the service route to the cemetery of the municipality.

7 Itinerary through the ridges of the Sierra d'Irta

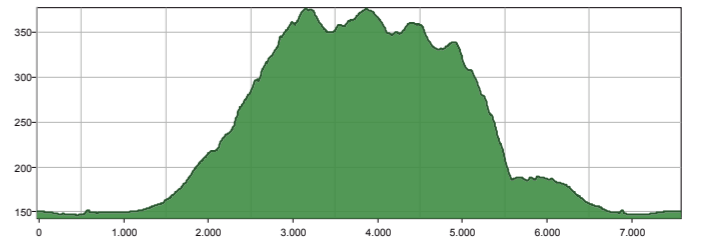
Departure: Ermita Santa Llucia and Sant Benet
Arrival: Hermitage Saint Antoni



Description of the route: Entering Alcossebre from the N-340 road, we find a roundabout and we deviate direction urbanization Las Fuentes. Then, following the signs of the Natural Park in the town of Alcossebre and finally direction hermitage of Santa Llúcia and Sant Benet, we arrive in the vicinity of the hermitage where we can leave the vehicle. From the parking area we will see the first wooden sign that tells us the start of the route. During the tour we pass through the Ebrí tower and following the path we reach the highest peak of the Campanilles mountain range (geodesic point). The wooden signs serve as a reference to follow the path. We continue to enjoy the views from the highest levels of the mountains, until we reach the Coll de la Palma and from here to the Mallada de la Rabosa, where the path becomes a track. Then we pick up the road signs and arrive at the hermitage of Sant Antoni. It is not a very difficult route, although the distance to be traveled is considerable.

4 Circular itinieray Xivert Castle - Assagador de la Serra

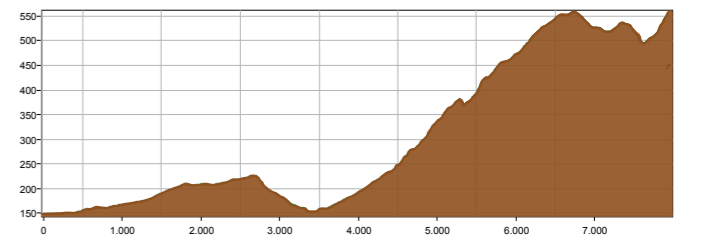
Departure: Road N-340 km 1023
Arrival: Road N-340 km



Description of the route: On the N-340 road, towards Castellón-Vinars, once past the entrance of the town of Alcala de Xivert, we see the dealers of the Seat and the Renault. There we find the sign that tells us to Xivert Castle. We start walking along a paved road that leads to the underpass of the highway. Once crossed, we turn left along the road that runs parallel to the highway, until we find the signal that tells us the climb to the castle. The itinerary runs along the north face of the mountain, on a gentle ascent, but continues to the castle. The descent takes place along the old livestock road "Assagador de la Serra", which gives us magnificent views of the front of the town of Alcala de Xivert and behind the Islamic fortress.

8 Race Itinerary – Pico Campanilles

Departure: Barranco de la Carrera
Arrives: Barranco de la Carrera



Description of the route: On the N-340 road, direction Castellón Vinars, as soon as past the entrance of the town of Alcao de Xivert we find a detour to the right (turn of 90o) that indicates hermitage of Calvary by this paved road (road of l'Estopet) we pass by next to the AP-7. After 1.8 km we see the detour that indicates Xivert Castle. Without leaving the road paved, and after 2.1 km we see a wooden sign that indicates ravine of Carrera. This will be the point where we'll leave the car to start walking. The ascent through the ravine allows us to enjoy the lushness of the vegetation and once on the top we already find on the left the sign that tells us Campanilles, the highest peak of the Natural Park (572 m).
